Guidelines for Paper Submission

- All papers should be prepared using Microsoft Word.
- Paper size should be A4, with margins: 1" (top, bottom & right) and 1.5" (left)
- All text should be typed in Arial font with size 12 and single-spaced.
- Title should be typed using uppercase (for the first characters of the words except preposition, conjunction etc.) and lowercase letters centered in the top of the first page.
- Title should be followed by name(s), institutional affiliation(s) and e-mail address of the corresponding author.
- First level headings must be in **Bold** font, left justified and numbered according to Level of headings as below:
 1. First Level Heading
 - 1.1 Second Level Heading
 - 1.1.1 Third Level Heading
- Header & Footer font size 8.
- Use italics for emphasis; and do not underline. Make a new paragraph or Page Break can be given to bring in a logical end to a page.
- An abstract of length not more than 250 words and author keywords should be supplied with the text.
- Length of full paper may preferably be limited to a maximum of 5000 words.
- Every paper must accompany a brief author(s) profile(s) (maximum 75 words) and a colour passport size photograph(s) for inclusion in the volume at the end.
- Illustrations such as photographs, charts, graphs, drawings, and diagrams should be labelled with caption, so that they correspond with their mention in the text (e.g. Table-1, Figure-2, Diagram-3).

Guidelines for References

- Provide the list of references at the end of the paper in sequence.
- References may be prepared using the APA 6th Edition citation style, with Author (Date) in-text citations where necessary.

In-text citations:

Example:

For quotations:

According to Garfield (1955), "....." (p.)

For Author(s):

Cronin and Meho (2006) showed....

(Cronin & Maho, 2006)

Representative examples:

Book:

Author, A. A. (Year of publication). *Title of work: Capital letter also for subtitle*. Location: Publisher.

Example:

Rowley, J. E., Rowley (1998). *The electronic library*. London: Library Association Pub.

Article or Chapter in an Edited Book:

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Year of publication). Title of chapter. In A. A. Editor & B. B. Editor (Eds.), *Title of book* (pages of chapter). Location: Publisher.

Example:

Eastwood, Elizabeth J. & Tompson, Sara R. (2001). Digital library services: an overview of the hybrid approach In Alison Scammell (Ed.), *Handbook of information management* (1-43). London: Aslib-IMI.

Journal Papers:

Author, A. A., Author, B. B., & Author, C. C. (Year). Title of article. *Title of Periodical*, volume number(issue number), pages.

Example:

Ho, S. M., Bieber, M., Song, M., & Zhang, X. (September 01, 2013). Seeking beyond with Integral: A user study of sense-making enabled by anchor-based virtual integration of library systems. *Journal of the American Society for Information Science and Technology*, 64, 9, 1927-1945.

Article from an Online Periodical

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Date of publication). Title of article. *Title of Online Periodical*, volume number(issue number) if available). Retrieved from <http://www.webaddress.com/full/url/>

Example:

Berg, R. C., & Nanavati, J. (January 01, 2016). Realist review: Current practice and future prospects. *Journal of Research Practice*, 12, 1. Retrieved from <http://jrp.icaap.org/index.php/jrp/article/view/538/449>

Web Document or Electronic Book

Example:

Gillespie, Colin, & Lovelace, Robin. (2016). *Efficient R Programming: A Practical Guide to Smarter Programming*. Oreilly & Associates Inc. Retrieved from Gillespie, Colin, & Lovelace, Robin. (2016). *Efficient R Programming: A Practical Guide to Smarter Programming*. Oreilly & Associates Inc.

Important Points to Note:

- Full-text of accepted papers will be published in the form of conference proceedings with ISBN number.
- It is essential that at least one of the author must register for the conference before registration closure date
- Papers whose authors do not register for the conference will not be included in the Proceedings Volume
- All accepted papers must carry a copyright declaration form as per the format available on website. (provide link.....)
